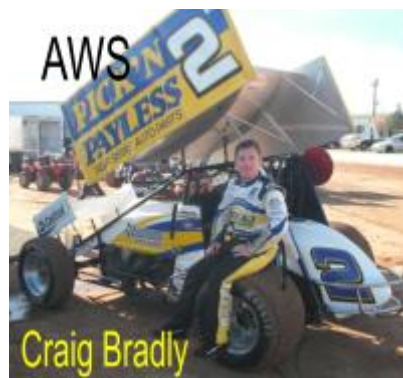
With five laps to go Saville spun in turn four to bring on the yellows once more.
