#### *Martin Laws Set Fast Time*

**In the Tyrepower sponsored sprinter Laws set** at a quick time of 12.1470 seconds to set the stage for what was to see some fast and furious action on the night.

**After four qualifying heats** held over 8 laps with race wins going to Lady racer Kelly Linigan, Mark Blyton, Damien Abbott & Roddy Bell Bowen. Next on the program were the trophy dash events which were taken out by Aussie Champ Garry Brazier & Robbie Farr.

#### *The B Main also presented by Tyrepower*

**The B Main event saw a spectacular win** go to Northern Territory star Danny Reidy over Warren Ferguson & Garry Rooke.

During the event two drivers exited the track in spectacular fashion as Craig Morrison and Clayton Hart both severley wrecked their rides as they flipped in turn four.

#### *The stage was now set for the 30 lap Tyrepower Main event.*

**WOW how is this for the front row** - Robbie Farr next to Garry Brazier. After the tradition four abreast salute the large crowd on hand settled in for a battle that can only be seen at TPCR.

The clay oval was still tack up high and most drivers had set their for high line running.

**The green fell** and it was Brazier who jumped away as Farr slotted in behind him with Roddy Bell Bowen hot on his tail tank. Right behind them it was Brooke Tatnell and Jeremy Cross battling for the minors.

**Farr was popping wheelies** down the main straight each time he got into the tack red clay as Brazier was making the gap wider.

**Damien Abbott spun in turn four** on lap five to bring on the yellows. The restart saw Brazier jump away again from Farr and Tatnell. **"how good is this look at the names, Farr, Brazier, Tatnell"** like to early days of PCR but it was only the fathers who drove before the sons were even old enough to race.

**Brazier was way out front** and up high exiting the turns at speeds of up to 160 KPH. Tatnell and Farr were on the gas after the high flying Brazier, Back in the pack it was Adrian Maher and Ian Madsen doing battle as as Kelly Linigan stopped on the track bring out the yellows.

**The restart saw Brazier again jump** away from Tatnell who passed Farr the lap prior. Now it was Bell Bowen doing wheel to wheel battle with Farr. Then it was the Aussie Forklift team of Linigan and Abbott who both spun in turn one, Abbott was out of the event as Linigan went to the rear of field.

**Again the green flag fell** and it was Brazier from Tatnell and Farr. Now it was Craig Brady and Jeremy Cross banging wheels down the main straight. Then the unthinkable, on lap 10 Brazier spun as he came out of turn four. This put Brazier to the rear of the pack of the snarling sprinters. As Tatnell inherited the lead with Farr right behind him, Maher pulled out of the event as Bell Bowen sat in third spot. Tatnell shot away from the field as now Jeremy Cross and Mitch Dumesny battled for the minors.

**Lap 11 and it was Robbie Farr** who hooked the cushion coming out of turn two and rolled the East Coast Pipeline special and he was also out of the event.

**The restart saw Tatnell jump away** again from Bell Bowen and Cross as now James Thompson and Craig Brady clashed wheels trying to catch the fast three up front.

**Tatnell was now lapping** the slower cars as the engines roared thrilling the crowd as Garry Rooke and Mark Blyton put on a dazzling driving display wheel to wheel action all the way.

**Thompson, Brady and Cross** were driving the Hoosiers of their cars three wide at times in turns one & two. The young Dumesny drove around Cross to secure third spot. With little laps left to travel.

**Brooke Tatnell went on to take a well deserved main event over Roddy Bell Bowen and Mitchell Dumesny.**
