Scott Darley Memorial

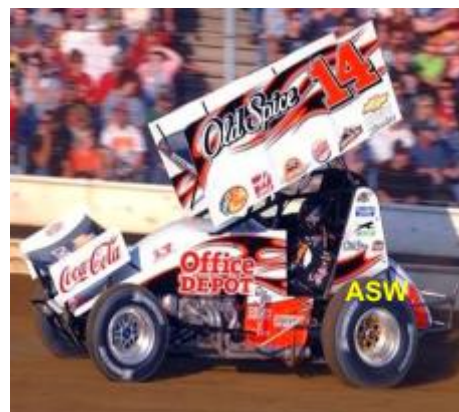
Weekend of January 2nd & 3rd sees the running of the Scott Darley Memorial with \$50,000.00 prizemoney. Again presented by Coca Cola.
